## **English GED Classes**

We have morning and night classes from 9:00am-1:00pm or 5:30pm-9:30pm Monday through Friday beginning

The class is 100% ONLINE

You will have a live teacher everyday for the entire class.

This is not a self-study class.

We offer GED in 100% Spanish or 100% English

You must have a laptop, a tablet is acceptable as well. You will need a laptop to test.

The program is free with the exception of the student paying for 2 official tests (\$36 per test) and buying one TI-30XS Calculator (\$17-\$20)

We pay for all practice tests (4)

You pay for the last test which is the math test. (You pay in the 8<sup>th</sup> week and it will be \$36) You will also pay for your Language Arts Test which will be \$36. (the third week of class)

If you have passed any portion of the GED test during or after year 2014 please let us know.

## **Class Structure**

Weeks 1-2 you study science and math then take the official Science Test

Weeks 3-4 you study language arts and math then take the official language arts test

Weeks 5-6 you study social studies and math then take the official social studies test and constitution test. (Constitution test is pass/fail and everyone passes it)

You do not need to take the Constitution test if you passed it in High School, 8th grade doesn't count.

Weeks 7-10 you study only math and take your official math test
